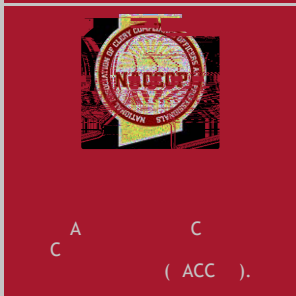




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Policy statement

- Prior to completion of the investigative report, the respondent and complainant, and their respective advisors, if any, will be provided a copy of the evidence in an electronic format or a hard copy. The parties will have 10 calendar days to submit a written response.

Internal procedure

External process information

- Prior to the completion of the report, you and your advisor, if applicable, will receive a Dropbox link to access a copy of the evidence. You will have until [DATE] to review the evidence and provide a written response to the [Investigator]. To provide the written response, use the following link: [submitter link].


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For it to be covered under Title IX, it must meet:

- New Definitions
- Jurisdiction of person
- Jurisdiction of activity


If it does NOT meet these requirements...

- Mandatory dismissal
- Can go to a different resolution process

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- Title VII
 - Hostile environment harassment below Title IX bar
- VAWA Requirements
 - Non-Sex-based Stalking
 - Domestic violence involving family member
- Other Sex-based behaviors
 - Gender-based discrimination
